Terry Kovel reports on dozens of cocktail accessories wanted by collectors. The auction included everything from swizzle sticks and their holders to cocktail shakers. Priciest item—an Art Deco chrome and glass cocktail tray sold for \$688. Collectors bid high for 20th-century Italian art glass and Kovels’ September newsletter has pictures and descriptions of some of the best pieces. See a 1930s Carlo Scarpa vase that sold for more than \$81,000, a Paolo Venini vase that brought \$72,100, and others. And some practical midcentury modern desks in warm woods with simple lines turned up at a couple of summer auctions. Find descriptions, pictures and prices of desks by Paul Frankl, Kai Kristiansen, George Nakashima, and others in Kovels’ September newsletter.

In “Kovels on Antiques and Collectibles” September newsletter you also see priced examples of lawman badges from the Old West, old and colorful Chinese firecracker labels with brand names like “Home Run,” “Yankee Boy” and “The Wizard.” Birds on etchings by Mark Catesby and figurines by Boehm are also reported. Kovel visited the White Ironstone China Association (WICA) annual convention and shows names and pictures of ironstone in a special exhibit. Regular monthly features such as the Dictionary of Marks featuring Boehm Porcelain, the popular illustrated Collector’s Gallery with answers to readers’ questions, and the Buyer’s Price Guide with current prices are also included.
